




The Mission of the Texas Federation of Republican Women (TFRW)

Fern Burke Scholarship

In May of each year, the San Antonio Republican Womens' club grants a \$1000 Fern Burke Scholarship to a high school senior.

SARW grants the scholarship based on grades, SAT/ACT scores, an essay submission, and involvement in any honors class participation, school award(s) received, school activities, school academic recommendations, character references, volunteer work and activities, and Republican Party activities.
